

QUARTERLY REPORT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF NAB KERALA & CARE AND SHARE USA PARTNERSHIP PROJECT (JANUARY –MARCH 2014)

PROJECT –Food, Health , Education Rehabilitation of visually and Audibly challenged and Multiple Disabled who are members from Below Poverty Line Families in Kerala State

About NAB Kerala – It is a Non Governmental Organisation Registered under the Charitable Societies Registration Act of 1955. NAB Kerala has started functioning with effect from 20th December 1962 and we have surpassed 52 years of services to the needy impaired people in Kerala. Our basic goal is to eliminate avoidable disabilities and also promote equality of opportunity for the impaired by protecting their rights. NAB Kerala have 209 life members and they are serving the society on an Honorary basis. We have only limited number of staff who are paid in a small way. NAB is possessing a land with a building in a prominent locality inside Trivandrum City Corporation. The place is about 5 KMs from the Railway Station and 9 KMs from Airport. We own the above two storied building with 3000 Sqft to accommodate the Rehabilitation and Training Centre for the impaired people in this state. We have in our credit a reasonably equipped Training & Development Centre for the Handicapped brotherens, Computer Centre for the Visually Challenged (supported by Amway Opportunity Foundation) Multiple Disability Centre (partially assisted by Care & Share, USA and a Low Vision and Vision Enhancement Centre (Sponsored by the Y;s Men’s International clubs.) All the facilities are functioning effectively in the same campus under one umbrella. The administration of the NAB is managed by a democratically elected Governing Council (38 members) under the able leadership of 21 member Executive Body. The day to day affairs are being handled by an Administrative Committee consisting of 10 (Ten) Honorary members

As reported early NAB, Kerala have conducted a survey at the Village bordering the forest area in Vithura, Palode, Kallara of Trivandrum District. Consequently we could register numerous house holds having various types of disabilities. On analysis and scrutiny study of the data collected we have enrolled numerous cases of visually, audibly and mentally challenged and 15 cases of Multiple disabled. For your information, furnishing below the names of some cases whom immediate care is required.
